Within this broad food sector, EDISA's level of specialization stands out particularly in the fishing, frozen food, canning, and aquaculture industries, where they have a large number of references, including some of the leading companies worldwide in this field.

LIBRA also provides extensive functionality to these companies, both at the operational level and in terms of control and decision-making support. It offers a significant advantage over other applications that lack the level of adaptation and vertical integration required by companies in this sector. In particular, LIBRA delivers great value in all aspects related to traceability, with comprehensive end-to-end process control.
